Philanthropic Fund Award Criteria

- ✦ Award is in the form of one major gift of \$15,000.00.
- ✦ Award will be one time as opposed to sustaining; however, recipients may apply again for additional awards in subsequent years.
- ✦ Award will be restricted to **capital projects** only. The South Bend Rotary Club Foundation does not consider computer hardware and software, the payment of salaries, tickets and/or operating expenses as capital projects.
- ✦ Preference will be given to projects located within the geographic boundaries of the City of South Bend.
- ✦ All projects must be sponsored by a member of the Rotary Club of South Bend.
- ✦ Recipient organizations must be not-for-profit (NFP) organizations or causes, which may include projects undertaken by NFP colleges or universities, departments of the City of South Bend, the South Bend Community School Corporation, etc.
- ✦ Selection committee will give consideration to the manner in which the South Bend Rotary Club will be permanently identified with the project and the length of time the project is expected to serve the community.
- ✦ Applications may be submitted along with up to three pages of optional additional supporting information to: wargom@cfhcare.org
- ✦ Applicants and sponsoring Rotarians will be notified via e-mail of the project that will be funded following final approval by the board of directors. Non-recipients will be notified via e-mail after the award has been presented.
