

Rotary Club of South Bend — Scholarship Program

Overview

The Rotary Club of South Bend supports the educational aspirations of local high school seniors who have demonstrated perseverance, integrity, and service to others. Through the **South Bend Rotary Charitable Foundation**, the Club offers two annual scholarships:

1. Phoenix Scholarship

Purpose:

To recognize students who have overcome personal or educational obstacles to complete high school and who are pursuing a four-year college degree.

Awards:

- Two scholarships awarded annually
- \$2,500 per year, renewable up to 4 years (\$10,000 total maximum)

Eligibility:

- High school senior attending a public or private school living in South Bend
- Minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA
- Planning to attend an accredited four-year college or university
- Sons or daughters of Rotary members are not eligible

Expectations for Recipients:

- Maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA each academic year.
- Submit an official transcript annually to the Rotary Club of South Bend.

- Conduct oneself in a manner consistent with Rotary's motto: *Service Above Self*. The Rotary Club of South Bend reserves the right to rescind any scholarship award should this obligation not be met by the student.
- Participate fully in Rotary's mentoring program, including:
 - Responding to communication from your assigned mentor
 - Using your mentor as a resource for academic and personal success

Payment:

Funds are paid directly to the student's college or university account and may be used for tuition, fees, books, or other education-related expenses.

2. Dr. S. Bernard Vagner Health Sciences Scholarship

Purpose:

In honor of the legacy of Dr. S. Bernard Vagner, long-time Rotary member and the first African American surgeon in South Bend. This scholarship is to support students pursuing studies in medical or health sciences at an accredited four-year college or university.

Awards:

- One scholarship awarded annually
- \$2,500 per year, renewable up to 4 years (\$10,000 total maximum)

Eligibility:

- High school senior attending a public or private school living or attending school in South Bend
- Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA
- Planning to major in a health sciences or related field
- Sons or daughters of Rotary members are not eligible

Expectations for Recipients:

1. Maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA each academic year.

2. Submit an official transcript annually to the Rotary Club of South Bend.
3. Demonstrate behavior consistent with Rotary's mission of *Service Above Self*.
4. Participate fully in the Rotary mentoring program.

Payment:

Funds are paid directly to the student's college or university account and may be used for tuition, fees, books, or other education-related expenses.

Required Application Materials

- 1. Completed Application Form**
- 2. Official High School Transcript and**
- 3. PSAT/ACT Test Scores (optional)**
- 4. Student Essay (500 words max):**
 - Phoenix applicants: Describe the personal or educational challenges you have overcome and what you have learned from those experiences. Describe your career goals.
 - Vagner applicants: Describe your academic achievements and commitment to the health sciences field, including your career goals.
- 5. Letter of Recommendation** from a counselor, teacher, or non-family member. For the Phoenix Scholarship, this letter should describe how the student overcame an obstacle.

6. **Acknowledgement Statement:** Confirm that you understand and agree to the scholarship expectations.
7. **Optional:** A second letter of recommendation.

Selection and Notification

- Applications must be submitted by the student.
- Counselors may recommend more than one student from their school.
- Qualified applicants will be invited to a short interview with the Rotary Scholarship Committee.
- Recipients and sponsors will be notified by letter and recognized at the **Rotary Awards Ceremony** on **Wednesday, May 20, 2026, 12 p.m.**
